To register for the examination, candidates must fulfill the following requirements: -

- a)** Certified true copy of Pharmacy Degree Certificate
- b)** Internship (Experiential training) reports
- c)** One recent passport size photograph
- d)** Copy of a National Photo ID/ Passport

Examination fees:

- I. Ghanaian Citizens trained in Ghana are required to pay four hundred and ten Ghana Cedis (GH¢410.00) only
- II. Non-Citizens trained in Ghana are required to pay three thousand, six hundred and eighty Ghana Cedis (GH¢3,680.00) only
- III. Foreign Practising Pharmacists seeking registration in Ghana are required to pay Four thousand, six hundred Ghana Cedis (GH¢4,600.00) only
