To register for the examination, candidates must fulfill the following requirements: -

- Certified true copy of Pharmacy Degree Certificate
- Internship (Experiential training) reports
- One recent passport size photograph

Examination fees:

- Ghanaian Citizens trained in Ghana are required to pay five hundred and twenty Ghana Cedis (GH¢520.00) only
- Non-Citizens trained in Ghana are required to pay an equivalent of eight hundred United States Dollars (US\$ 800 EQ) only
- Foreign Practising Pharmacists seeking registration in Ghana are required to pay an equivalent of one thousand United States Dollars (US\$ 1,000 EQ) only
